Field of activity:

As an International Peace Worker you will be supporting our partner organisation together with a local peaceworker through following activities:

- Conceptual design of training modules in the area of civil nonviolent conflict transformation in the informal education sector
- Preparation and implementation of trainings and professional development courses for teaching staff (Training of Trainers/ToTs)
- Development of a portfolio of training materials as well as an online resource bank
- Development and strengthening of an alumni network and a pool of trainers, as well as the organisation of network events
- Participation in network activities in the education sector and representation of the partner organisation in relevant fora
- Strengthening of relevant capacities of the partner organisation
- Strengthening and further development of M&E systems
- Participation in relevant internal processes of the organisation
- Supporting the partner organisation in processes of institutional strengthening in accordance with identified needs
- Ascertaining accurate financial transactions and reporting in regular communication with the KURVE Wustrow main office
- Close cooperation with the regional coordinator on ongoing conflict and security analysis
- Supporting the planning of networking and advocacy activities in Germany if applicable

Requirements:

- Degree or equivalent experience in peace and conflict studies, or another relevant field
- Training/professional development courses in civil nonviolent conflict transformation or similar field
- Several years of practical work experience with NGOs, preferably in intercultural teams and/or abroad
- Work experience in the education sector, specifically with a focus on the design and implementation of training modules and ToTs
- Experience in the organisation of larger events
- Expertise and experience in project management, incl. M&E
- Experience in working with audiovisual media and design programmes (e.g. Photoshop) would be desirable
- Context knowledge and work experience in Myanmar would be an asset
- Team player with intercultural competences and the ability for self-reflection
- A high degree of flexibility and resilience
- Willingness to travel to remote areas with basic living standards
- Professional command of English, knowledge of Burmese would be an asset

Myanmar is a tropical country. Applicants should be aware of living and working conditions in such a climate environment.

Contractual Conditions:

We offer a contract in accordance with the German law for development aid workers (only for EU-citizens, incl. Switzerland) until 31 December, 2019, including a preparation period in Germany expected to commence on 16 September 2017.
